

## Conference Report

The ICERI2015, the 8th annual International Conference of Education, Research and Innovation brought together students, academic staff, business leaders, media personalities and NGO's in important discussions of the most important questions facing those in education today: How education should be provided? What are the newest learning methodologies? How can we learn in an innovative way? In a world of rapid technological changes, how can we adapt to the changes in its due time?
