

# Trip overview

Melecon 2016 (Mediterranean Electrotechnical Conference) took place in Limassol, Cyprus. It is an IEEE Region 8 flagship conference with a long standing history of excellence both in electrotechnology and in recent years in information and communication technologies as well. It covered complementary thematic areas that hold great promise for the advancement of research and technological development in the solution of complex engineering systems.

Our paper was accepted for short oral and poster presentation. The paper studies interactions between host computers and all-programmable systems on chip through PCI-express bus which enables the fastest data exchange to be achieved. It suggests a number of support modules that allow simple interactions with general-purpose software running in a host PC and with application-specific software and hardware.

The conference was 3 days long and contained multiple presentation sessions. The conference included 8 tracks of oral presentations, 3 short presentation sessions, 2 special sessions, 3 plenary sessions and poster sessions.
