The IEEE European Test Symposium (ETS) is Europe's premier forum dedicated to presenting and discussing scientific results, emerging ideas, applications, hot topics and new trends in the area of electronic-based circuits and system testing. ETS also features a special track on Emerging Test Strategies (ETS²), where new problems and ideas can be discussed in an informal atmosphere. ETS is the major event of the European Test Week that also includes TSS (Test Spring School), and fringe workshops. This year the conference consists of 8 technical sessions, 3 poster sessions, 3 keynotes, 2 discussion panels and 3 embedded tutorials. The keynotes present such interesting topics as "Securely Connected Vehicles – What it takes to make self-driving cars a reality", "Is IoT Coming to the Rescue of Semiconductor?" and "Testing in the Year 2024 – Big Changes are Coming".

The participation in the conference gave me a good opportunity to discuss the current problems in field of test with a leading researchers and persons from an industry. This knowledge I can re-use in my future research and supervision of student works.
